Work is well underway and detailed below are the site waste summaries for February and March.

February

Total Tonnage of Waste:	21.96

Total Tonnage of Waste:	65.91

These figures fall in line with the general plan for the Visitor Centre. A rainwater harvesting system will be installed generating water for washrooms, and solar panels will provide heating alongside the heat generated from the treatment works' incinerator.

The centre, which is Yorkshire Waters' first waste water visitor centre, will provide school children, community groups and the general public with an opportunity to learn about how the company treats sewerage and safely returns it back to the environment.
